URBACT in a nutshell

- ◆ European Territorial Cooperation programme (ETC) co-financed by ERDF
- ◆ All 28 Member States as well as 2 Partner States (Switzerland and Norway) are eligible to participate
- ◆ Main objective: To promote integrated and sustainable urban development in European cities
- ◆ Main target: City practitioners and representatives

Why apply to be a Transfer Network?

'Good Practice City' sharing the experience > a 'mentor' role

'Transfer cities' understand>adapt>reuse the good practice

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS:

GOOD PRACTICE CITY

- ◆ Refining and improving its own methodology
- ◆ Wider recognition of the potential for re-use and greater visibility

TRANSFER CITIES

○ Producing a 'Diary of Transfer experience' >



Eligible Beneficiaries

‘Eligible beneficiaries’ cities in the 28 Member States plus Norway and Switzerland (labelled Good Practice city can be partner once as well as lead partner once)

‘Lead Partner’ MUST be a labelled URBACT Good Practice city (Each city can lead and submit an application for ONE Transfer Network)

‘Transfer cities’ understand>adapt>reuse the good practice. Cities can only participate in ONE Transfer Network



Partnership and Phases

Phase 1 (6 months)

3 city partners including the Good Practice City (Lead Partner)

At least, 1 partner from 'less developed' region

◆ There can not be 2 cities from the same country.

Phase 2 (24 months)

5 - 8 partners

Max. 2 'non city' agencies

Between 2 - 4 partners from less developed regions depending on partnership size

→ There can not be 2 cities from the same country.

Last 6 months dissemination focus



Budget and Expertise

Phase 1 (6 months)

Maximum total eligible cost of 80.000€

26 days paid expertise

Phase 2 (24 months)

Maximum total eligible budget 600.000€ including Phase 1

120 days paid expertise

More developed regions – 70% ERDF

Less Developed and Transition Regions – 85% ERDF

Swiss partners – 50% national funding

Norway partners – at own cost

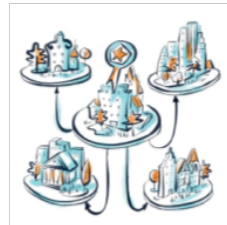

- Good Practice City + min. of 4 and max. of 7 Transfer Cities
- Expert support
- Budget of up to 600.000€ (Phase 1 and 2)
- URBACT tools
- URBACT Capacity building activities
